**Directions:** Take Highway 281 South to Marble Falls. Highway 281 intersects with Highway 71 five miles south of Marble Falls. Go underneath the bridge and back around to take Highway 71 East, travel approximately 17 miles. Highway 71 T-intersects with F.M. 2322 at a full stop light. (Landmarks at this intersection include a Chevron station and Security State Bank). Turn here and head North. Continue 5 miles to Pace Bend Park guard booth. Tell them you are going to Highland Lakes and continue straight on the main road. Highland Lakes' entrance will be 3.5 miles into the park on the left.

Tri-Rivers Baptist Association purchased a former hunting lodge with over 100 acres and are utilizing it for retreats and youth/children events. They have requested assistance with building a chapel on the property which will seat approximately 100 people. This will be a slab up, 1,687 sq foot building. No plumbing will be done, but all other trades needed. We will be parking in an RV park which is next to the lodge and chapel.

### **Directions:**

When I put the address into my GPS, there was no such address; however when I put in Tri-Rivers Baptist, it came right up. We drove in using the Hwy from Hico, as below, and left traveling to Gatesville. There was construction on the route to Gatesville, so do not recommend going that direction.

From Hico, turn on Hwy 281 South toward Hamilton. Travel 0.9 miles to 1602 and turn South (Left). Follow 1602 for 10 miles and turn Left on 219 at the T. Travel 1 mile and take a Right on CR 227. The lodge is located 3/4 miles down 227 on Right and the camping site is just past lodge.

I know we are all excited about getting back to work. Come one, come all!!!! We will make room. Also there are a lot of rooms and beds inside the lodge that can be used. No need to bring linens.

As we write this letter, tomorrow is the Christmas Party in Whitney. We will miss you if you are unable to attend. Praying each of you has a safe and Merry Christmas! SYDTR in 2019.
